At least 20 years experience in one of the archival fields,

Experience of research teaching and training work for at least five years,

Published papers or publications on the subject concerned,

Junior Fellowship:

A Master's Degree in History and allied discipline of interest to Archives with a paper on post 1600 period of Indian History (preferably Diploma in Archival Studies from the NAI) published papers should be a desirable qualification

A Masters degree in Chemistry or physics –
Publications are desirable.
