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PREFACE

The present volume, second in the series, completes the work regarding cataloguing of proscribed publications housed in the National Archives of India Library. The earlier volume 'Patriotic Poetry banned by the Raj' was brought out in 1982 and, as evident from the title, it contained patriotic poems only. Besides these poems infused with high patriotic fervour, spanning the tumultuous period of over two decades ranging between 1919—42, there were brought out publications in prose. These were written in almost all the Indian languages and published in different parts of the country. These included speeches, articles, essays etc. Set on a war-path against the British Raj, this literature aimed at arousing patriotic feelings in the minds of the people and invoking them to rise up 'to free India or die in the attempt'. Consequently, the British thought of stopping these publications reaching the people and banned their circulation.

Now that after long slumber and struggle, India stands forth again 'awake, vital, free and independent', 'and the soul of a nation long suppressed' finds utterance, it is only proper to throw open widely this hidden treasure to the public. Our experience through various exhibitions organised by the Department has also shown that there is a general inquisitiveness about this little-known, yet so vitally important, source material housed within the four walls of the National Archives of India. I trust the publication of these two catalogues would greatly satisfy the curiosity in the minds of the general public and the scholars, wanting to know the heroic endeavours made to keep the atmosphere continuously charged, infusing thereby the much-desired feeling of faith and confidence in our struggle for freedom.

Patterned on the earlier catalogue dealing with poetry, the present catalogue contains publications almost in all the regional languages of India with the break-up as under :—
