

Private Archives Section – National Archives of India

The **Private Archives Section** of the National Archives of India is an important repository dedicated to the preservation of India's rich documentary heritage. The Section preserves historically significant private papers and archival collections relating to India's political, social, cultural, literary, intellectual and nationalist history.

The collections preserved in the Section include private papers, correspondence, manuscripts, diaries, speeches, photographs, newspapers, journals, pamphlets, rare books, judicial proceedings, press clippings, scientific papers, literary works and records. These collections belong to eminent national leaders, freedom fighters, scholars, writers, scientists, social reformers, administrators and public figures who played a significant role in shaping modern India.

The records preserved in the Section span from the seventeenth century to the contemporary period and include material in English, Hindi, Urdu, Persian, Bengali, Marathi, Gujarati, Tamil, Telugu, Kannada and several other Indian and foreign languages. The collections provide valuable information on India's freedom struggle, revolutionary movements, constitutional developments, journalism, literature, education, labour movements, philosophy, diplomacy, science and cultural history.

The Section preserves important papers relating to personalities such as **Mahatma Gandhi, Dr. Rajendra Prasad, Subhas Chandra Bose, Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, Gopal Krishna Gokhale, Lala Lajpat Rai, Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, Sarojini Naidu, Lal Bahadur Shastri, Morarji Desai, K.M. Munshi, Gobind Ballabh Pant, Raja Mahendra Pratap, Srinivasa Ramanujan** and many other prominent figures associated with India's national and intellectual history.

The Private Archives Section also preserves records relating to important historical events and movements such as the **Indian National Army, Indian Independence League, Lahore Conspiracy Case, Meerut Conspiracy Case, Kanpur Conspiracy Case, Champaran Satyagraha, Bardoli Satyagraha**, and various revolutionary activities during the colonial period.

The archival material preserved in the Section is acquired through donation, purchase, transfer, deposit and Deeds of Gift received from individuals, families, institutions and organizations. The Section undertakes the arrangement, listing, preservation, conservation and servicing of these records to ensure their long-term preservation and accessibility for research purposes.

The Private Archives Section serves as an important centre for historical research and is widely consulted by scholars, researchers, students, writers and academic institutions from India and abroad. Through the preservation of rare and valuable records, the Section contributes significantly to safeguarding India's documentary heritage for future generation.
